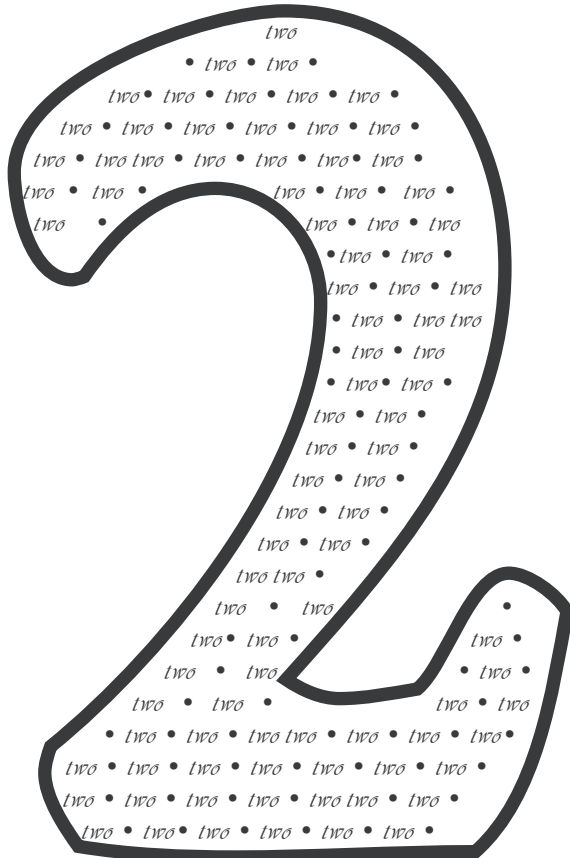

Text in Text



Looking for a great way to make your numbers stand out on a page? Try this technique.

1. Type number or letter. AYT YellowJacket at 100pt was used in this example.



2. After making it the size needed for the page, go to the type menu to Create Outlines.

3. Change the fill to none and



T,

the stroke to whatever point size needed to make the effect you want. 5pt was used here.

4. The next step is to select your text tool and click inside the number or letter and start typing, continue typing until area is filled. We used AYT KendallScript at 10pt. Finished sample at top of page.

This effect would work well for graduation years and anniversary dates.
